### **Additional Documentation Required**

- ✓ Identification for Partner 1 and Partner 2 (i.e.: birth certificate, driver's licence, passport, etc.).
- ✓ Single and widowed people do not have to prove current marital status. Divorced people must provide proof of divorce:
  - Canadian Divorce – Certificate of Divorce or Decree Absolute or Divorce Irrevocable (Quebec) or Certificate of No Appeal (prior to July 1, 1968)
  - Out of Country (document in English) – must state divorce is final or dissolved (it is not acceptable if the document indicates that the divorce will take effect in 3 mo. or 30 days etc.)
  - Out of Country (document not in English) – as above but a notarized translation of the document is also required
